

How to choose your sailing course

It makes them discover the marine environment through various games and activities, both on land and at sea. From foot fishing to building aquariums or ship models, from sailing on a boat to setting a fish pot, and much more, the young sailors will be able to sharpen their marine skills.

Optimist

This small boat, **which was first built** in 1947 in the United States **of America**, has conquered the children's **heart** and **has** become the essential boat for young people.

It is suitable for children **from the age of 7**, allowing them to take their first sails **autonomously**. Sailing in pairs **to start with**, **the more adventurous ones will quickly be sailing solo**, it is also well-suited **to perfect their solo skills**. **Number of participants is limited to 10 per course**.



Fusion

This very simple boat is very good small double-handed dinghy suitable for 9 year old and above.

Lastly, things are getting serious with this small dinghy equipped with a jib, so you can sail with a friend on a slightly faster boat. It will allow you to discover the joys of balance on the water. Ideal after a few Optimist courses, it is nonetheless very suitable for beginners.

Courses are limited to 12 participants, which makes a fleet of 6 boats to have fun with together.



RS14

With this Catamaran, we move to a two hulls boat, to discover speed and power, but it remains maneuverable and provides very good sensations.

It is designed for young people from 12 years old because the crew's weight is important to tame the beast. Experienced sailors will love this high-performance, fast boat and will be able to improve their positioning, particularly with trapeze work and sail trimming. For beginners, it's a way to discover sailing on a stable and easy boat. Courses are limited to 12 participants for a fleet of 6 boats.



Topaz 16


In the big leagues, the big brother of the Topaz 14, is therefore more powerful and, above all, is equipped with a spinnaker.

It **suits** an older audience, from at 15 years old **and above** . It **will give you the same sensations and progression as the RS 14**, with the added extra benefit of the spinnaker on downwind courses. **Courses** are limited to 12 participants for a fleet of 6 boats.



Windsurfing

No need to introduce it, it's suitable from 11 years old with small sails, as well as for adults. Balance is the golden rule for this **baby**, and completing your first tacks **will be** very rewarding.
